WWR Hotel:

Hyatt Regency Toronto

We have arranged for a number of special rate hotel rooms at the The Hyatt Regency in downtown Toronto. This is also the hotel where our Gala will be held on the Sunday. The Friday optional tour will also be starting from this location. St. Basil Church and the Royal Ontario Museum are fairly close and easily accessible by public transportation or a short taxi ride.

The Hyatt is located in the heart of Toronto's Entertainment District. It is an area filled with Toronto's past history and is at the same time a centre for dining and theatre. Here you will find the Roy Thomson Hall, the Four Seasons Centre for Performing Arts, the Princess of Wales Theatre and the Royal Alexandra Theatre.

The hotel is also in close proximity to major attractions such as the Royal Ontario Museum, the Art Gallery of Ontario, the Beta Shoe Museum, the CN Tower and many more of Toronto's landmark. Ripley's Aquarium of Canada, a \$130 million facility, located next to the CN Tower opened a few months ago. It is a world-class aquarium with nine galleries. For shopaholics, the Hyatt is also close to Toronto's shopping centre, The Eaton Center.

The other deciding factor for choosing the Hyatt is because the Ontario Committee is quite confident that the catering manager Celly Kan-Holbrook would do her best to look after her fellow Maryknollers.

Transportation to and from the airport:

For those Maryknollers who require a transfer from the Pearson International Airport to the Hyatt Regency, there is a shuttle bus that services all the downtown hotels. The buses leave the airport every half hour at 10 minutes and 40 minutes after the hour starting from 5:10a.m., with the last bus leaving at 00:10 a.m. The ticket of \$29.95 per person can be purchased on board the bus.

The Hyatt also provides a pre-booked limousine service at the rate of \$75 from Pearson International Airport. Pre-booking is required 24 hours in advance by calling the hotel concierge at 416-343-1234 providing the name and number of travellers, flight details, the date and time of arrival.

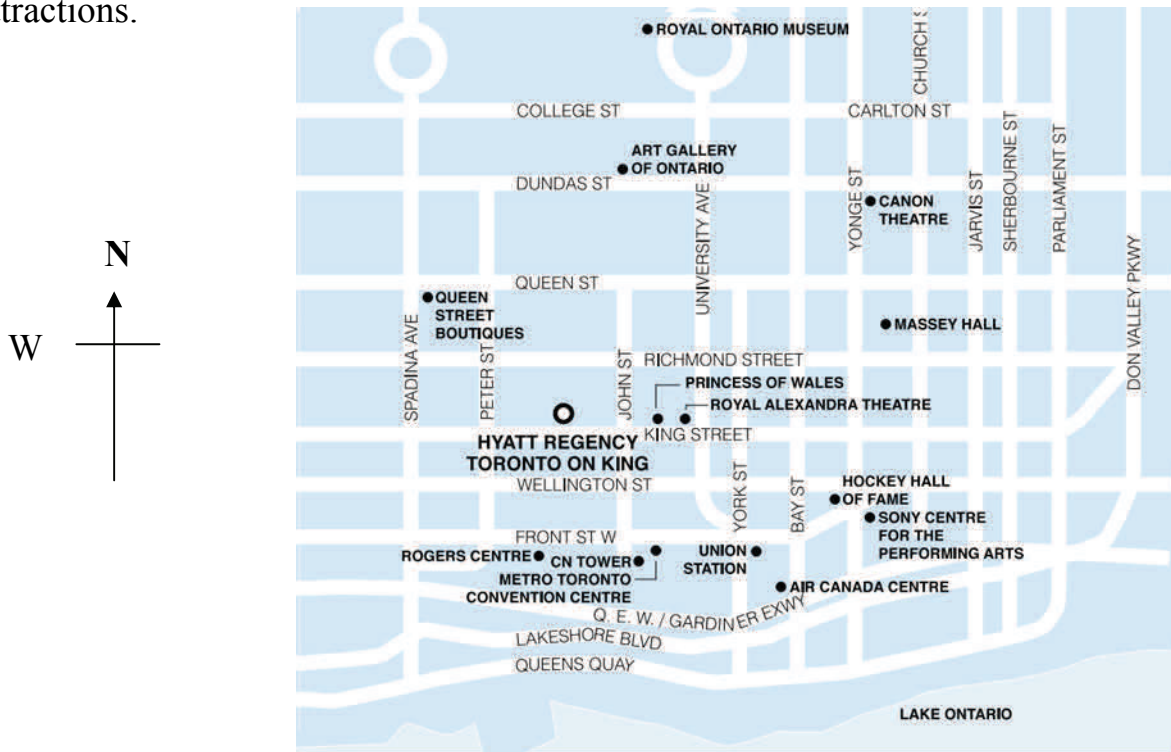
There is also the option of using the services of a Toronto Chinese limousine service called Link Union. Pre-booking is required and the regular pick-up service is \$45 from Pearson International Airport and they are also available to take bookings around the Toronto area by calling 416-299-5999.

Parking:

Overnight parking at the Hyatt is \$32 with in and out privileges. For those attending the Gala, Sunday evening parking rates from 5p.m. to 5 a.m. are only \$6.

Once you are at the hotel you can easily walk to many places. The weather is typically sunny and around 25 celcius. The subway is a mere five-minute walk or two stops on the streetcar that stops in front of the hotel.

For your convenience, this map shows the Hyatt Regency Hotel and its surrounding attractions.

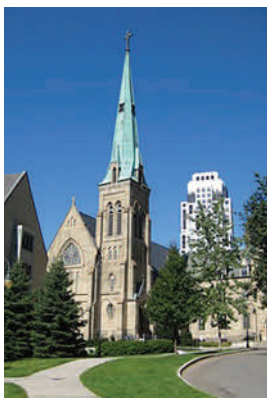


Tour of Niagara Falls and Niagara-on-the-Lake Wineries, Friday August 1, 2014

Interior View



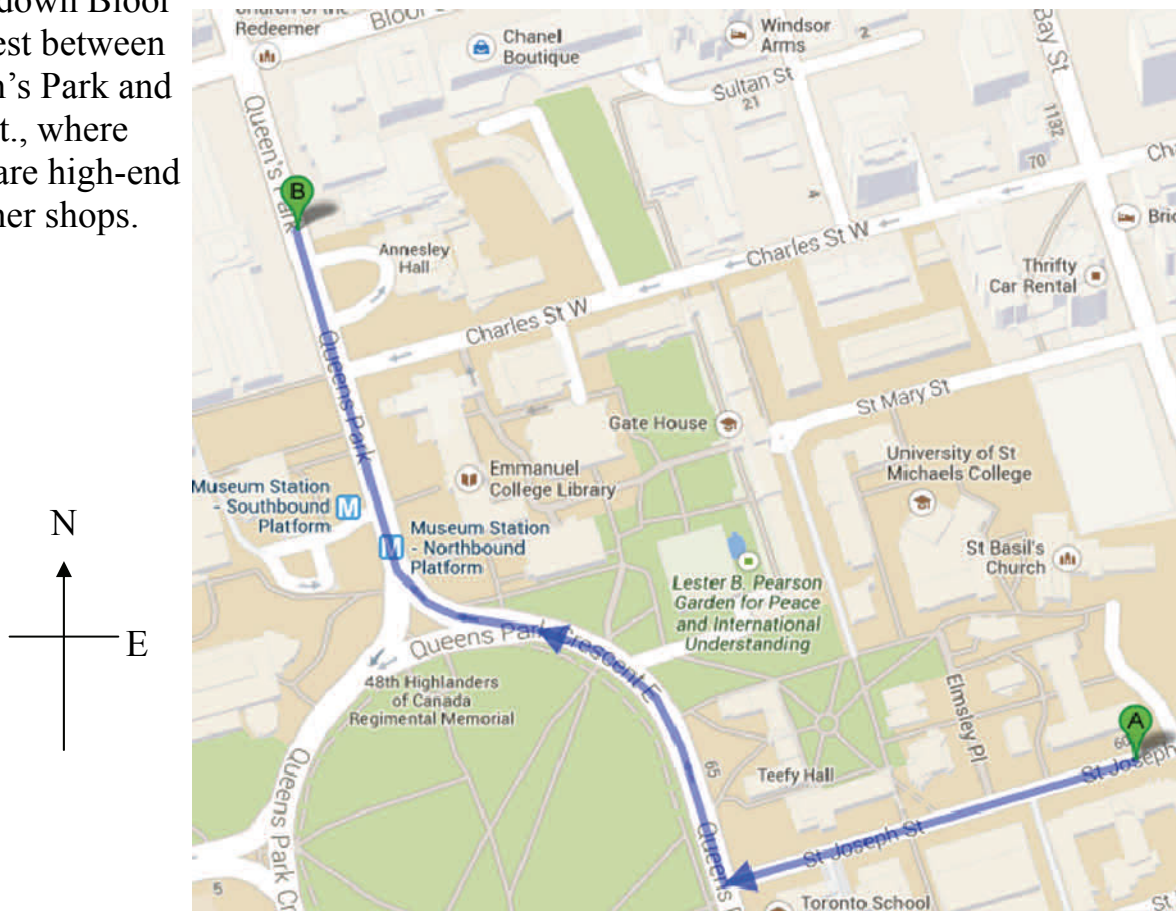
Resurrection Window

St. Basil's Church is located in the heart of downtown Toronto on the St. Michael's College campus, University of Toronto. It is the third oldest Roman Catholic Church in the City. It is a wonderful old church with lots of history, and beautiful surroundings. The Basilian Fathers, the religious order of priests that founded the University of St. Michael's College and St. Basil's Church in 1856, runs the Church to this day.

Father Chris Valka, Pastor of St. Basil's, will celebrate Mass with us. As this Mass is dedicated to Maryknoll's WWR and 30th anniversary of our association, we will choose our own Readings, Responsorial Psalms, Gospel Acclamations, and Prayers of the Faithful. It will be a trip down memory lane when we sing the hymns we sang at Maryknoll along with our very own choir led by Michelle Man ('91). Let us know if you wish to participate in this choir.

Following Mass, we can socialize in the church basement or in the beautiful church garden. It will give us an opportunity to catch up with our schoolmates before we head off to the Royal Ontario Museum for the registration and cocktail reception.

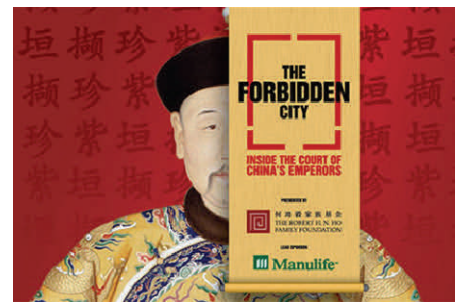
Royal Ontario Museum

The Royal Ontario Museum (ROM) is among the world's leading museum of natural history and world cultures, attract-



ing over one million visitors a year. The ROM's Chinese collection acquired over the years is one of the best in North America.

The building where we held the last Toronto WWR in 1998 underwent a make-over by the world renowned architect, Daniel Libeskind in 2007. The entrance to the museum is now located on Bloor Street under the stunning Crystal which is now a very important Toronto landmark.

The year 2014 is a very important year at the ROM as it marks its 100th anniversary. We are fortunate to be able to hold our registration and reception in the Curry Gallery on the main floor after the museum is closed to the public that evening. We will be providing private docent tours of the Asian Galleries and, as a special treat, also view the centennial exhibition of the *The Forbidden City: Inside the Court of China's Emperors*, a block buster exhibition on loan from Beijing, beginning March 2014.

If you feel that the night is still young after the ROM reception, there are numerous restaurants and coffee shops in the vicinity where you can continue your soirée.
