

Thanks to the tireless efforts of the Organizing Committee and everyone who contributed their time, hospitality and generosity, the event was a tremendous success!!

The evening's festivities included a Silent Auction (all items were donated), Karaoke (performers were: Michelle Man, Beryl Chan, Juliana Shea Joe, Amy Lo, Jeffrey Fong, and David Wong), and a Fashion Show.

We were fortunate to have ten Sisters join us this year. Since then, we have always surpassed that figure and this year was no exception.
