(Report of the Biennial General Meeting Dinner

The Biennial General Meeting was convened at the Westin Prince Toronto (Prince Hotel) after a sumptuous buffet dinner attended by some 55 members. Copies of Membership Directory (Sept. 2010) were distributed at registration. As usual, the evening was filled with great camaraderie among Maryknollers.

Ludia Fong, in her Report as out-going President, emphasized on the importance of further support from all members for the on-going networking dinners/fund-raising projects for the Motherhouse,

**Financial Reports** presented by our Treasurers for the years ending 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2009 and 30<sup>th</sup> April 2010 reflected a healthy situation. A special vote of thanks was registered for the very capable administration of our Treasurers, Patricia Wu and Lily Yeung, as well as for the unfailing financial support given by Dr Shirley Cheong and Eva Wong.

The following motions for the **amendment of the By-Law No. 1**, presented by Linda da Rocha Little, were passed **unanimously** :

- i/ Remove the requirement for the life members of the Maryknoll Convent Former Students (Ont.) Inc to elect the President, appoint a legal advisor and appoint an auditor at the General Meeting;
- ii/ Permit service of notices by email. Members without email address will continue to receive notices by mail.

The **newly formed Committee** for the subsequent two-year term, comprising of eleven members, was presented to the Meeting.



We were honoured to have Nancy Tong (1971) who specially flew in to Toronto for our Biennial General Meeting to talk to us about the film "*Trailblazers in Habits*".

Nancy is a filmmaker and a professor at the University of Hong Kong. She is renowned for "**In the Name of the Emperor**" which won the Special Jury Award at the San Francisco International Film Festival in 1995. She also collaborated on films, including "**Cancer: From Evolution to Revolution**," which won the George

Foster Peabody Award in 2001 and "Who Killed Vincent Chin", which was nominated for the Best Documentary Film Category of The Academy Awards in 1989. To commemorate Maryknoll Sisters' 100th Anniversary and their remarkable contribution to the development of modern Hong Kong, Nancy was asked to produce a film to document the Maryknoll Sisters' work in Hong Kong. After extensive research, she discovered that the Sisters' work actually went beyond the two schools which are so well known to people in Hong Kong, and that their work had gone unnoticed. Therefore, together with a group of the Maryknoll alumnae, Nancy took up the task to produce this film. Nancy plans to have the film launched in time to coincide with the 100th anniversary celebration of the Maryknoll Sisters Congregation in 2012. However, even with Nancy and her teams, donating their time, money and effort to produce such a film, there is a substantial cost involved. She has campaigned, with the help of Motherhouse, to help with the financial aspect of this film. All proceeds from the film will be donated to the Motherhouse. Donations should be sent to the Motherhouse, and tax deductible receipts can be issued by the Motherhouse to US citizens.

Mimie Lee Ho passed away suddenly on March 11, 2010 in Vancouver. She taught English, dancing and physical education at MCS from 1965 - 67 before emigrating to Canada. She taught elementary school in Clearwater, B.C. before enrolling at U.B.C. Vancouver. In 1973, Mimie founded the Strathcona Chinese Dance Company to promote Chinese dance art and it quickly grew to be a world renowned dance troupe.



Mrs. Marina Tso (Miss Poon to her students) taught Chinese at MCS for over 20 years before emigrating to U.S. in the late seventies. She had been living in the senior centre in Los Angeles for over 40 years. In her last days, she had ill health but decided not to have any surgery because of her age. In the final week, she was hospitalized, and managed

to see all her children and grandchildren before passing away on May 29, 2010 at the age of 90. She is survived by two sons and a daughter, all living in LA.
